With reference to your memorandum advising that Mulwalla House will be ready for occupation about 31st October, 1947, I have to state that the undermentioned arrangements have been made for the transport of guests and staff to and from this establishment :-

(1) Additional 'bus to depart from Ainslie each morning at approximately 8.0a.m. picking up at a point in London Circuit between Constitution and Commonwealth Avenues and approximately 220 yards from Mulwalla House at 8.15a.m., thence travelling via Beauchamp House and No. 4 route to Kingston.


(2) Additional 'bus to depart from Kingston at 4.50p.m. on No. 4 Route to Beauchamp House thence via London Circuit, setting down at a point approximately 220 yards from Mulwalla House.

(3) The present 7.0p.m. 'bus ex Aerodrome Monday to Sunday, after setting down at Civic Centre, to proceed via London Circuit and Commonwealth Avenue picking up in Commonwealth Avenue at 7.20p.m. at a point close to the entrance of the R.C. Presbytery, and situated approximately 225 yards from Mulwalla House, thence travelling via Commonwealth Avenue Bridge and Barton to the Capitol Theatre, continuing on to the Railway Station ~~is~~ required.

(4) The 11.0p.m. Aerodrome 'Bus ex Capitol Monday to Saturday and the 10.0p.m. 'bus ex Services Hut Sunday, to travel the reverse route as outlined in paragraph 3 setting down in Commonwealth Avenue for Mulwalla House.

(5) As no indication is given in the attached memorandum regarding the distribution of the personal to the various offices, no arrangements have been made for transport between Mulwalla House and City, the distance between the two latter places being considered within a reasonable walking journey.

(6) Provision has been made on the new time table, (which it is expected will operate early next year) for a more frequent service past this point on both up and down journeys.
