Australians have a unique opportunity to see the Pope in Canberra without the discomfort of the huge crowds expected in Sydney and Melbourne.

His Holiness will kiss Australian soil for the first time when he arrives in Canberra on Monday 24 November 1986.

After being welcomed by the Governor-General, Sir Ninian Stephen, and the Prime Minister, Mr Hawke, he will travel to Canberra's National Exhibition Centre to celebrate his first Australian open-air Mass.

Visitors will have an unhindered view of the Pope at the Centre. His Holiness will celebrate the Mass on a raised podium allowing the entire congregation to participate in the service.

To coincide with the Papal Mass in Canberra and to make it easier for you to be part of this historic event, the Canberra Tourist Bureau has arranged several tours to the national capital

Your luxury coach will transport you to and from the Mass and on sightseeing trips around the city.

DAY 1

Saturday 22 November 1986.

8.00 am Coach departs Wollongong Travel Centre, Keira Street.

Arrive Canberra and enjoy a tour of the national capital.

Overnight, including dinner at the Forrest Lodge Motor Inn or similar motel.

DAY 2

Sunday 23 November 1986.

Breakfast at your motel, followed by Mass at St Christopher's Cathedral, Manuka, and a tour of the City which takes you to the War Memorial, National Gallery, New and Old Parliament House, Black Mt Tower, and the High Court. A luncheon cruise on Lake Burley Griffin and a city lights tour will also be included.

Overnight, including dinner at your motel.

8.00 am Breakfast at your motel, followed by a free morning to relax or shop before leaving for the National Exhibition Centre and the Papal Mass.

Saturday 22 November 1986

8.00 am Coach departs from Albury Civic Centre.

On Arrival in Canberra, lunch at Regatta Point Exhibition (cost of lunch not included), and then enjoy a tour of the National Film and Sound Archives, Cockington Green, New Parliament House, the Serbian Church and Telecom Tower.

Overnight, including dinner at the Red Cedars Motel, Watson, or similar.

DAY 2

Sunday 23 November 1986

Breakfast at your motel followed by Mass at St Christopher's Cathedral, Manuka. Then enjoy a tour including the War Memorial, High Court, the Embassies, Prime Minister's Lodge, the Carillon and the Australian Defence Forces Academy.

Overnight, including dinner at your motel.

DAY 3

Monday 24 November 1986

Breakfast at your motel followed by a visit to the Australian Institute of Sport and Belconnen Mall. (one of Canberra's largest and best shopping centres), before leaving for the National Exhibition Centre for the Papal Mass.

Depart Canberra for Albury.

COST \$153.00 including coach transport, dinner bed and breakfast and entry to attractions.

THE POPE'S CANBERRA ITINERARY

Monday 24 November 1986

3.15pm: The Papal aircraft arrives at RAAF Base, Fairbairn, and his Holiness kisses Australian soil for the first time. He is received by Sir Ninian Stephen and Mr Hawke. His arrival is marked by a 21 gun salute. (Free public access).

3.55pm: The Pope leaves Fairbairn and travels by Popemobile to the National Exhibition Centre, Mitchell. (Best vantage point War Memorial).

4.25pm: The Pope arrives at the National Exhibition Centre, Mitchell, and is driven through the congregation.

4.50pm: Celebration of the Eucharist.

7.10pm: He leaves by Popemobile for Government House.

7.40pm: The Pope arrives at Government House.

8.00pm: Leaves for Parliament House to attend a Government reception.

9.25: Leaves for Apostolic Nunciature, Red Hill.

9.30: Arrives — remains overnight.

Tuesday 25 November 1986

9.15am: Leaves for RAAF Base Fairbairn.

9.40am: Arrives at Fairbairn Air Base to be farewelled by Government and Church leaders.

10.00am: Leaves Canberra for Brisbane.
